Irrigation season is about to begin. Have you paid your irrigation maintenance fees and ditch rider fees? Lou Logoz will not be the ditch rider this year. Many of you are aware that Lou had vision problems last fall and the problems have not cleared up to where he can do the irrigation this year. Irrigation and maintenance fees are due by April 15th. Ditch rider fees are used to pay the ditch rider and the maintenance fee is for the payment of City water shares with the Canal Company. Maintenance fees also go toward paying for upkeep of ditches, pumps, etc. Unpaid maintenance fees are added to property taxes with a penalty. Please get them paid before that happens.

Lon and Melanie Egbert are the owners and would be happy to have you come in and check out their awesome new building.

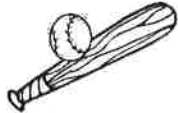
DaRosa Farms is also new in town, doing business as R&R Holsteins, having purchased the building directly south of the Post Office.
