The City is finding that citizens are bringing in prebuilt sheds, many from Old Hickory Sheds in Jerome and placing them on their property without a proper City permit. Any structure that is over 200 square feet, permanent or temporary MUST have a building permit issued before you take delivery of such a structure or build one yourself. The old city code was 120 square feet, and that was changed to 200 square feet, but a permit is still needed for anything over the 200 sq.ft.
